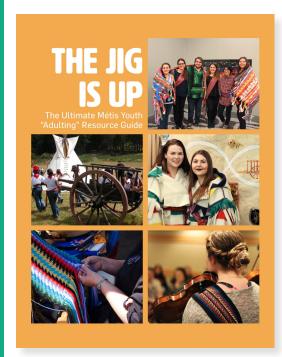

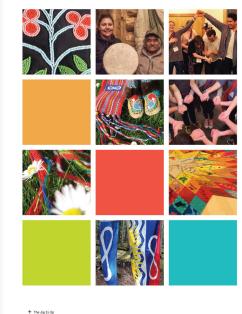

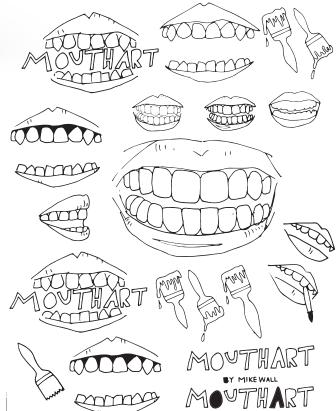












DGD BROCHURE
